About ICFAI University, Sikkim

The Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India University, Sikkim popularly known as The ICFAI University, Sikkim has been established under Section 4(2) of the ICFAI University, Sikkim Act 2004 (Act 9 of 2004) passed by Legislative Assembly of Sikkim. The University has been notified under Notification No. 9/LD/2004 Dated 15th October, 2004. The University is recognised under Section 2 (f) of the UGC Act 1956 and empowered to award degrees under Section 22 of UGC Act. The University is a member of the Association of Indian Universities. New Delhi, Member of Association of Commonwealth Universities, UK, United Nations Global Compact and ECOSOC.

Location

The ICFAI University, Sikkim, Gangtok is located at the picturesque Himalayas in the Shivalik Hills of the eastern Himalayan range, at an altitude of 1,437 metres (4,715 ft); bestowing it with natural landscape and being blessed with an enviable cool climate throughout the year. The University can be lauded for its connectivity by air and road transport. Gangtok meaning 'lofty hill' was said to have been a small village until it gained the status of an important pilgrimage centre. Gangtok rose to prominence as a popular Buddhist pilgrimage site after the construction of the Enchey Monastery in 1840. In 1894, the ruling Sikkimese Chogyal, Thutob Namgyal, transferred the capital to Gangtok. In the early 20th century, Gangtok became a major stopover on the trade route between Lhasa in Tibet and cities such as Kolkata (then Calcutta) in British India. After India won its independence from

Britain in 1947, Sikkim chose to remain an independent monarchy, with Gangtok as its capital. In 1975, after the integration with the Union of India, Gangtok was made India's twenty-second state capital.

First public airport 'Pakyong Airport' was operational from September 2018 onwards, which connects Gangtok with other parts of India. Now, instead of taking flights from Bagdogra (125 km away), passengers can directly board and depart from Gangtok, for other cities.

Recognitions & Awards

University Grants Commission (UGC): The ICFAI University, Sikkim is empowered to award degrees under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. The University has been notified by the UGC, under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 vide Notification No.F.8-9/2009 (CPP-I) dated October 27, 2009.

Bar Council of India (BCI): The Bar Council of India has granted approval for offering 5 year BBA-LLB (Hons.), BA-LLB (Hons.) and 3 year LL.B Programs at the University.

Admission Fee: :

Admission Fee (One Time) of ₹3,000 for UG/PG programs and ₹10,000 for Ph.D. programs is to be paid by all the students along with the application forms

Exam Fee:

All the students need to pay an amount of ₹2,000 per semester for UG & PG programs and towards Exam Fee along with the Program Fee. For Ph.D Programs an amount of ₹10,000 as the exam fee must be remitted at the time of thesis submission.

Caution Deposit:

All students are required to pay a Caution Deposit (One Time) of ₹5,000 along with the First Semester Fee and will be refunded without interest to the students on completion of the Program. Caution Deposit shall not be adjusted to any fee dues etc.

Program Fee:

Students have to pay the fee at the beginning of each semester, as per the due dates which will be notified separately at the relevant time.

Remittance:

All payments should be made by way of NEFT, UPI, Debit Card, or Credit Card on "The ICFAI University, Sikkim" website under the Online Semester Fee Tab only.

Course Work Fee:

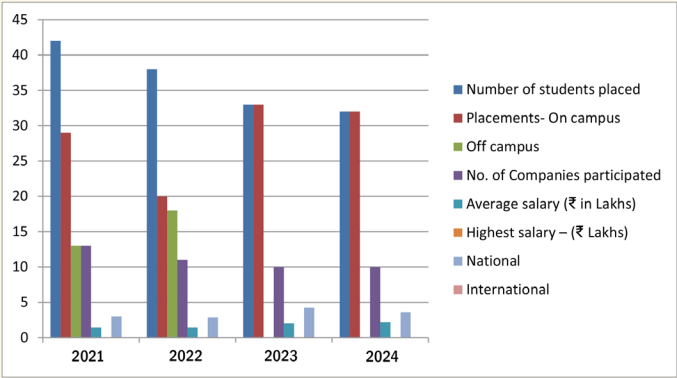
Ph.D students need to pay ₹2,500 as the course work fee at the time of registration.



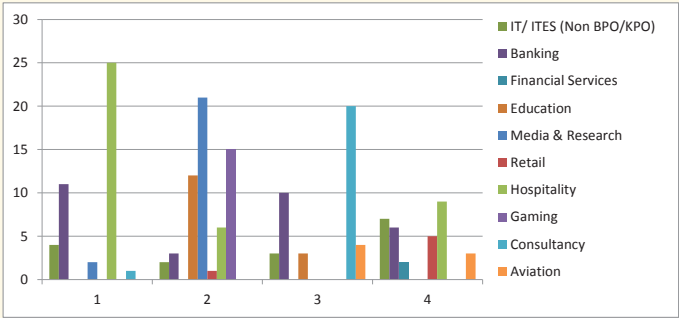

Merit Scholarships

The ICFAI University Sikkim offers merit scholarships to students pursuing the UG & PG Programs. The scholarships are based on performance in Class XII (or equivalent)/ Graduation (or equivalent) and Semester-wise performance during the Program.

A. Merit Scholarships based on past academic record:

Percentage of marks achieved in qualifying examination will decide the amount of scholarship. The Scholarship will continue semester after semester only on maintaining the minimum 6.0 GPA. The Merit Scholarship will not be given if there is RRA / NC / supplementary in the semester. The students availing Govt. Quota seats will not be eligible for scholarships based on Past Academic Record. However, they will be eligible for scholarships based on semester-wise performance.
